R Coaches: Reservations required.

✉ Sleeping Cars: First Class Viewliner® Service.

- Amtrak® ClubAcela® available in New York, Philadelphia and Washington and private waiting area available in New Orleans, for First Class Service passengers.

✉ Dining Car: Full meal service.

✉ Lounge Car: Sandwiches, snacks and beverages.

✉ No Smoking: Smoking is prohibited entirely on these trains. Passengers may smoke on station platforms as announced by train crews, and must remain next to the train, ready to board immediately upon hearing the locomotive horn and verbal "All Aboard" calls.
